Safety	Buoyancy aids to be worn as per Racing Yearbook 2018 by all Division 7, 8, 9, 10 and Lightning paddlers, including K2.
Rules	As per Marathon Racing Yearbook 2018 - note club colours must be worn to score Hasler points. Paddlers paddling in the Lightning races must paddle Lightnings and not any other type of craft.
Facilities	Toilets available in shopping centre.

The Race Result data showing Name, Club, Finish Time, Placing and Division (with promotion/demotion indicated) may be published and held on BDCC's website and social media sites until the Race Result data has been published by MRC. Paddlers may request deletion of their historical data by contacting the Marathon Race Committee (MRC) in accordance with MRC's data protection policies.
